They can also access the class website for lots of review.

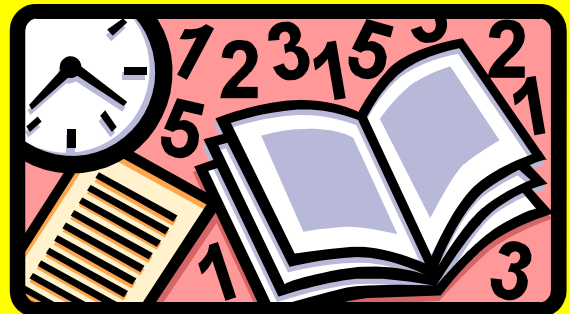
I will also be holding a couple of midterm review classes after school until 2:40. The dates are not set in stone yet, but I will let the students know about them at least a week in advance.
